Hazard	Risk	Risk Level (H/M/L)	Precautions (Action) required to reduce the level of risk
Eggs in the Basket	Slips and trips; twisted, coiled or knotted ropes, wet grass, planks and other structures Heavy handling of timbers Being accidentally hit by a pole or plank by another member of the team Wooden poles springing up from the ground	M/L	Health & Safety briefing prior to activity DO NOT allow any attempts at a direct lift of the structure – the solution is simple with levers Be aware of the positions of other members of the team at all times
Site Safety	Slips and trips Falling objects High winds Water, pond Tree stumps Animals Infection Allergies Irritant plants Animal excrement Infection	M/L	Give site safety talk and warn participants of risk. Advise not to run and to look were they are going. Advise must stay with group and not to wander off. Advise participants that hand washing is essential before eating or drinking Do not approach animals

Guidance note: Severity of injury

Low –minor injury (cut, bruise etc) to one person
 Medium – minor injury to several people or medium injury (cut, broken bone etc) to 1 person
 High – medium injury to several people or major injury/death to one or more people

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
