

Redstone Centre Health & Safety Rules for Visitors

The Redstone centre is set within 18 acres of farmland and you may come across the following natural hazards within the site:

Slips and trips
Falling objects
High winds
Water
Tree stumps
Animals
Infection
Allergies
Irritant plants
Animal excrement

In order to protect your Health, Safety and Security whilst visiting our site, please adhere to the following rules:

- Do not run, jump or climb
- Look where you are going at all times
- Stay with your group at all times and do not wander off
- Do not walk through closed gates unless with a member of staff
- Hand washing or use of anti-bacterial gel is essential before eating or drinking
- Do not approach the animals
- Stay away from the pond
- Do not pick any plants
- Personal belongings are the responsibility of the individual
- No alcohol or illegal drugs can be brought on to the site
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only
- No fires are to be lit without the express consent of the instructors and must not be left unattended
- Customers are responsible for any equipment issued to them during the course and will be liable for loss or breakage
- All equipment must be returned in the same condition it was issued in
- Customers must comply with all reasonable instructions and directions from the instructors
- No knives must be used until the instructors are satisfied that the client has been fully instructed in their safety
