Trust Walk	Slips and trips – disoriented people walking whilst blindfolded, wet grass, changes in surface underfoot and other structures Individuals becoming overly uncomfortable if blindfolded for a long period of time	M/L	Health & Safety briefing prior to activity Running & Jumping are not allowed Time limited to 30 mins
Site Safety	Slips and trips Falling objects High winds Water, pond Tree stumps Animals Infection Allergies Irritant plants Animal excrement Infection	M/L	Give site safety talk and warn participants of risk. Advise not to run and to look where they are going. Advise must stay with group and not to wander off. Advise participants that hand washing is essential before eating or drinking Do not approach animals First Aid kit will be available First Aiders will be on site, nearest A&E Dept is Leighton Hospital, Crewe.
